

Patient Visits to Empaneled Providers

IHCRC has a goal of being your medical home. That means that each patient is assigned to a specific medical provider. The majority of your visits will be with your Primary Care Provider, or PCP. If your PCP isn't available, you will likely see another provider on the same medical team. This encourages a better patient-provider relationship by establishing trust and good communication with you and your provider.

We recently did a study of the 2021 patients and their providers, and learned that 86% of all patients were seen by their PCP during the year. Our accrediting organization, AAAHC, has a goal of at least 50% of patients seeing their PCP during the year. We are pleased that we are able to exceed that goal.
